

5 elements of a Localscape

Follow these steps to start your own plan:



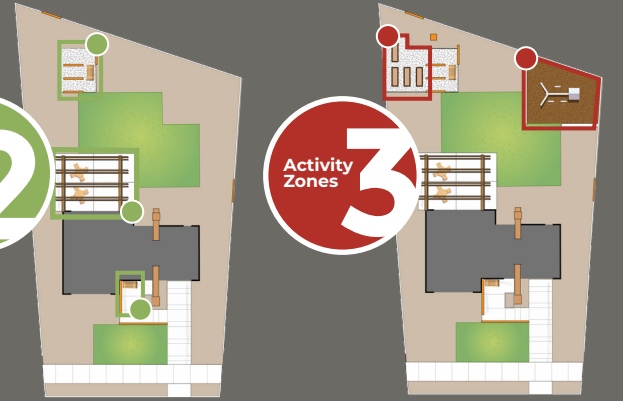
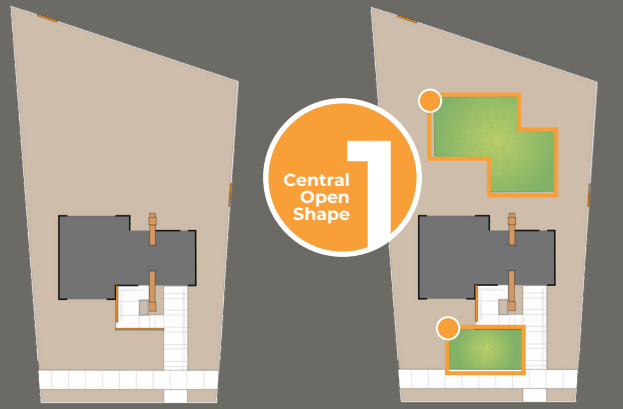
1
Central Open Shape
 The defining element of a Localscape, the central open shape can be lawn, hardscape, groundcover, gravel, or mulch.

2
Gathering Areas
 Hardscape spaces to gather with friends and loved ones—like patios, seating areas, fire pits, and decks. May function as Central Open Space in landscape without lawn.

3
Activity Zones
 Areas outside of lawn designed for your favorite activities, like horseshoe pits, trampolines, gardens, and hot tubs.

5
Planting Beds
 The remaining spaces become the planting beds—the finishing touch to your Localscape.

4
Paths
 Connect the previous elements with pathways. Paths are never made from lawn but can be concrete, pavers, stone, or compacted mulch.
