RESOLUTION NO. R52-2023

**A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE CANVASS OF THE
2023 HERRIMAN MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION**

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2023, the municipal general election was held; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to UTAH CODE ANN. § 20A-4-301(2) (a), the mayor and the municipal legislative body constitutes the board of municipal canvassers for Herriman (“*Board*”); and

WHEREAS, on December 5, 2023, at 5:00 p.m., the Board met to canvass the election returns at its usual place of meeting; and

WHEREAS, the election returns for each voting precinct in which polls were open have been received; and

WHEREAS, the Board publicly canvassed the returns and determine from them the votes of each voting precinct for each person voted for.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board as follows:

Section 1. The Board hereby certifies and approves the general election results for the 2023 Herriman Municipal General Election held on November 21, 2023.

Section 2. Attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference are the election returns and the votes of each voting precinct for each person voted for.

Section 3. The following candidates, having qualified by the highest number of votes, were hereby elected for a four-year term as Council members of Herriman during the November 21, 2023, municipal general election:

Section 4. The city recorder is hereby designated as the election officer for purposes of this election.

Section 5. The election officer has prepared a report of the results and the same has been reviewed and declared correct.

Section 6. The election officer is directed to file a certified report in the records of the city.

- Section 7.** The election officer is directed to prepare and transmit a certificate of election under official seal to each elected official.
- Section 8.** The election officer is directed to publish a copy of the certified report in a newspaper with general circulation in the city and posted it in a conspicuous place within the city.
- Section 9.** The election officer is directed to file a copy of this resolution and certified report with the Lieutenant Governor's office on or before the second Friday following the municipal primary election.
- Section 10.** This resolution shall take effect immediately.


