As we enjoy the summer season, it's a great time to reflect on the vibrant growth of our local business community. In recent years, Herriman has welcomed waves of new businesses, significantly expanding the range of services and stores available within our city boundaries. Gone are the days when we had limited options for dining and shopping. Today, we are proud to have multiple grocery stores, a hardware store, a variety of quality sit-down and take-out restaurants, and an increasing amount of retail options, including a sporting goods store.



In 2023 alone, 18 new businesses opened their doors in Herriman. Our community now offers a wide array of services, such as auto maintenance, barbers and salons, dental care and surgery, physical therapy, banks and credit unions, and quality childcare. July is here, and it's a great excuse to throw an epic BBQ party, with fireworks, flags, and food! While there's nothing like busting out the grill, and celebrating our independence surrounded by our favorite people—here's a few reminders on firework safety:

- Always follow instructions on the packaging
- Keep water close by as a precaution
- Never give fireworks to small children and keep children at least 10 feet away from the firework area
- Be aware of your surroundings and never aim fireworks towards people, animals, vehicles, structures, or flammable material
- Never relight a firework that didn't go off
- Fireworks are not allowed to be discharged in city parks
- Follow local and state laws and regulations

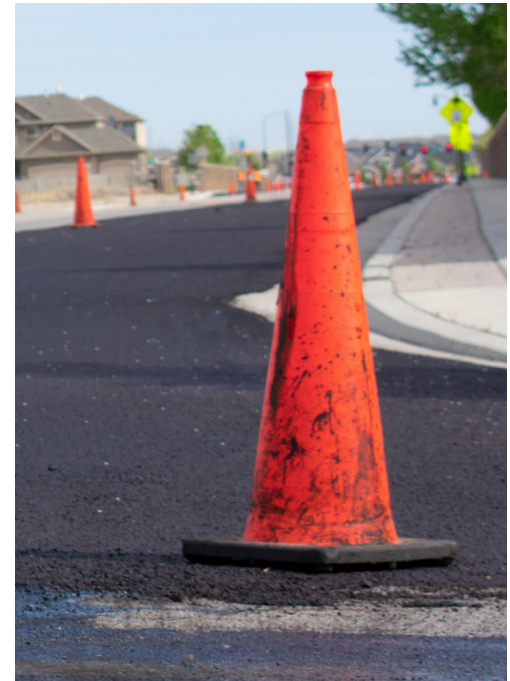

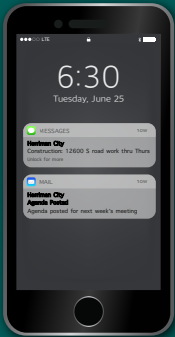
Road surface treatment
